Event Notes

- St John's Ambulance will be based at the |Working Men's Institute (opposite the Bridge Inn).
- (Lift entrance available at the rear of the WMI building).

- The designated qualified 'First Responder' will be based in the HQ at the Bridge Inn Hotel (Tel Julie Mattin 376800)
- A defibrillator is available in the former telephone box beside the approach road to Christ Church (beside the Co-Op store on New Road Laxey). SJA will also be in attendance – based at Laxey WMI.
- Bands to play approximately 25 minutes set at each venue and then have 30 minutes to make their way to next venue and set up ready to play.
- Session 4 - all bands gathered at the Rose Gardens/Village Square to play several tunes together or as agreed by consent with the winners of the previous year's event.
- During the afternoon, the Commissioners will put on refreshments for band Members, probably light finger food, etc. These will be served downstairs in the Laxey WMI.
- The Commissioners have a policy to reduce single-use plastic, but drinking water will be available at all times at the Laxey WMI on New Road; and will be available on request to the marshals at each venue.
- Judges to be announced in due course.
- Distances between venues:
 - Laxey Pavilion to The Miner's Statue In [approx 350m (3+ minute walk)]
 - Laxey Pavilion to Mines Tavern [approx 250m (2+ minute walk)]
 - Mines Tavern to Miner's Statue [approx 100 m (2 minute walk)]
 - Laxey Village Square to the Glen Pavilion [approx. 200m walk} (2 minute walk)
- Commissioners will provide transport for any Band Members who might need assistance between venues (Contact Martin tel. 422148).
- Commissioners to provide chairs at each venue.
- Bands to bring music stands if possible (these to remain in situ. for band following?)
- Percussion to remain in situ. for band following?
- Commissioners can provide van/s to transport any large instruments/equipment between venues.
- Parking is available (See parking map below). **Please note the Commissioners are hoping to secure the use of the Princes Motors site for this purpose (confirmation to follow).**
- If **any** parking issues on the day for any Band Members please call Martin on 422148 and we'll sort a space very quickly.
