16.46		<b>Matters for Discussion:</b>	
	a.	To approve Garff Commissioners Memorandum of Understanding dated 29.03.16. <i>The contents of this document were noted. No changes were requested. The document was signed by <b>Mr Quayle</b>.</i>	
	b.	To discuss insurance provision for Year 2016/2017 for Garff Commissioners. <i>Two quotations for insurance for the Garff authority were considered. Members resolved that Maughold would support engagement of Zurich Municipal for the 5 year period through Rossborough.</i>	
	c.	To discuss arrangements for 'Heritage Open Day Event', Sunday 2 <sup>nd</sup> October 2016. <i>The clerk was instructed to forward details of a walk to 'Rhenab Waterfall' to be led by <b>Mr Quayle</b> in September.</i>	
	d.	To discuss request from the Headteacher at Dhoon School for assistance with community project. <i>A document was circulated. It was agreed that further information would be sought from the school.</i>	
	e.	To discuss new method of allocating payment for disposal of household waste and waste from the CA sites to be implemented from the 1 <sup>st</sup> of April 2016. <i>It was agreed that no payments would be made to government until full details of the revised charging mechanism had been sent to the Commissioners.</i>	
16.47		<b>Parish Maintenance and Health &amp; Safety Matters:</b>  To discuss tree management at Maughold Village Car Park. <i>It was agreed that maintenance of the trees would be delayed until after the toilet block was constructed as an application for work to take place would require a new planning application be submitted. This would delay the construction process and have implications on other projects.</i>
